JACKSON HOLE

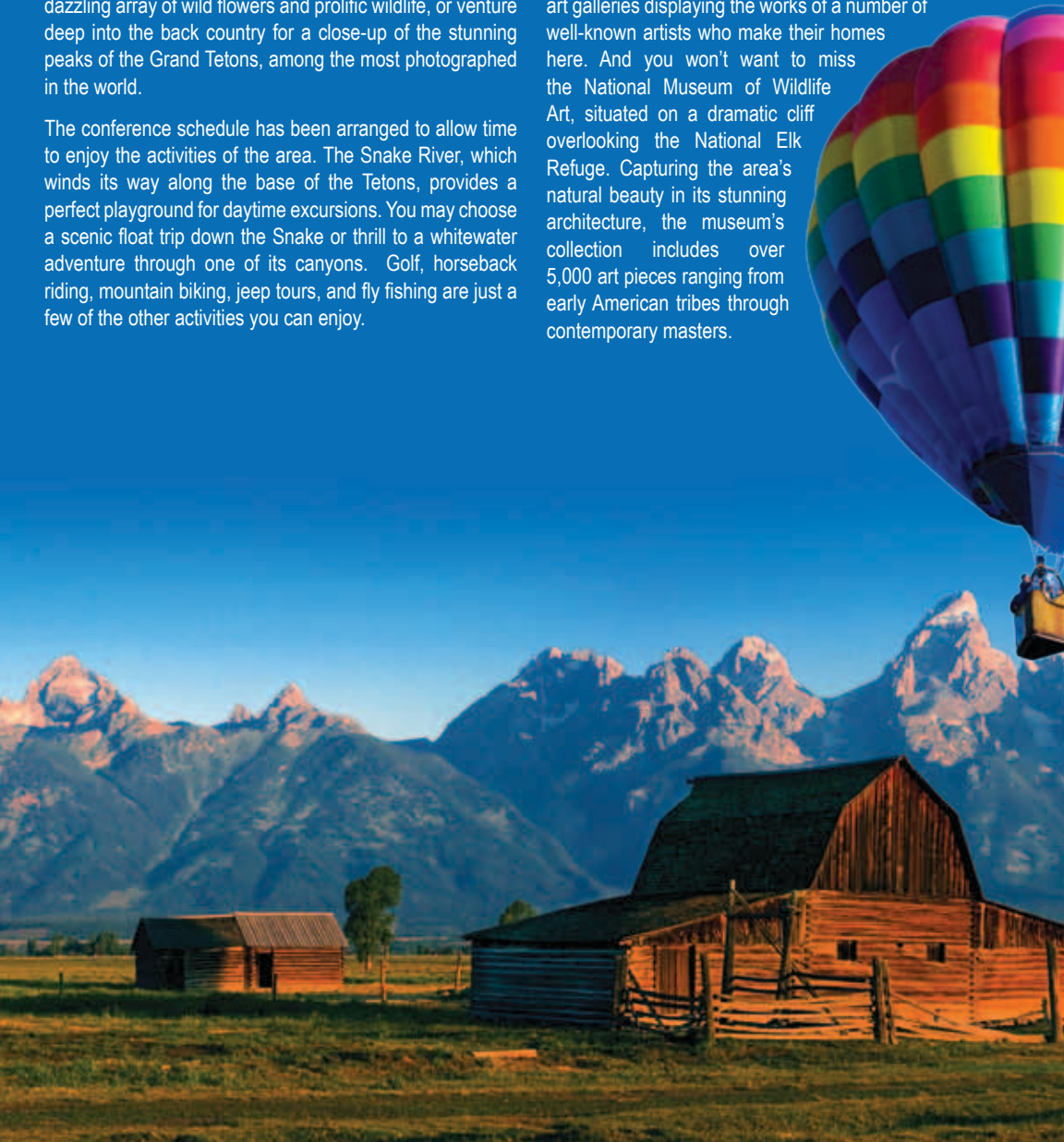
